SHEFFIELD ENGLAND - Big alert - deadline for guaranteed entry is February 18, 1996. Entries received between 2/18/96 and the formal deadline of 5/18/96 will be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Managers, to ensure that the meet can be run within reasonable hours. The latest word is that entries have been pouring in and accommodations are getting tight but there are still accommodations available. A World Forum will be conducted on July 21st at Ponds Forge covering Masters swimming at World Championships and other Masters events. This forum will then be held every four years. Two delegates per Federation will be allowed to speak. A Questionnaire on future programs for World Masters Swimming Championships will be distributed to the swimmers at the meet.

<u>RULE BOOK</u> - The 1966 rule books are now available from the USMS National Office, 2 Peter Ave., Rutland, MA 01543 for \$7.00 each, postpaid.

<u>COACHES</u> - There is a new Coaches Manual - 3-ring binder - available from the National office for \$20.00. A dozen of our most notable coaches across the country share their expertise. Yearly updates to be provided.

1997 LC NATIONALS - Larry Peck, representing Team Orlando Masters, and Julie Sundstrom, of the Orlando YMCA International Drive Aquatic Center, submitted the bid which was accepted. The USMS National LC Championships is the first in the Florida LMSC since the USMS National SC Nationals were held at Indian River Community College in Ft. Pierce in 1986.

RANSOM ARTHUR AWARD -The nomination deadline is March 15th. This award is given in honor of Captain Ransom J. Arthur, M.D. who by his sacrifice, perseverance, and dedication to improving the health of adults through swimming, established the Masters Swimming program in the United States. The award is given annually to the person who has done the most to further the objectives of Masters Swimming. LMSCS, the Board of Directors, Committee personnel, and individual Masters Swimmers are urged to submit your nomination of a worthy contender. A concise justification (one page or less) should accompany your nomination.

LMSC NOTES

The <u>GEORGIA</u> LMSC has scheduled several Hour Swim sessions for the January to encourage Georgia participation for this National event. A one-day developmental meet will be held February 4th in Marietta. The big event, the annual St. Patrick's Day Invitational is March 16&17: out of state entries go out later this month. Killer Whale and former Olympian Geoff Gaberino was a participant in the 12 mile Swim Across Miami Open Water Relay on Dec. 30th. Geoff is also actively involved in the Swim Across America promoting cancer research.

Carl House, <u>FLORIDA GOLD COAST</u> LMSC, in a joint effort with the USMS Top Ten Committee is making an attempt to identify Top Ten swimmers for a particular LMSC. This capability is new and is likely to have errors in the identification of LMSC for some swimmers. Some errors or oversights due to the fact that some swimmers do not use the same name from one meet to the next, some meet entry people introduce variations on names, and because there are cases where two or more swimmers use identical names. Age and birthday have been included in the database in an attempt to reduce errors. The list of swimmers who made Top Ten and the number of events they made it in can be 1) sorted by age and sex; 2) sorted by club; and 3) list of all Top Ten swims made by these swimmers. So far, this has been done for four LMSCs who have provided Carl with their registration database.


